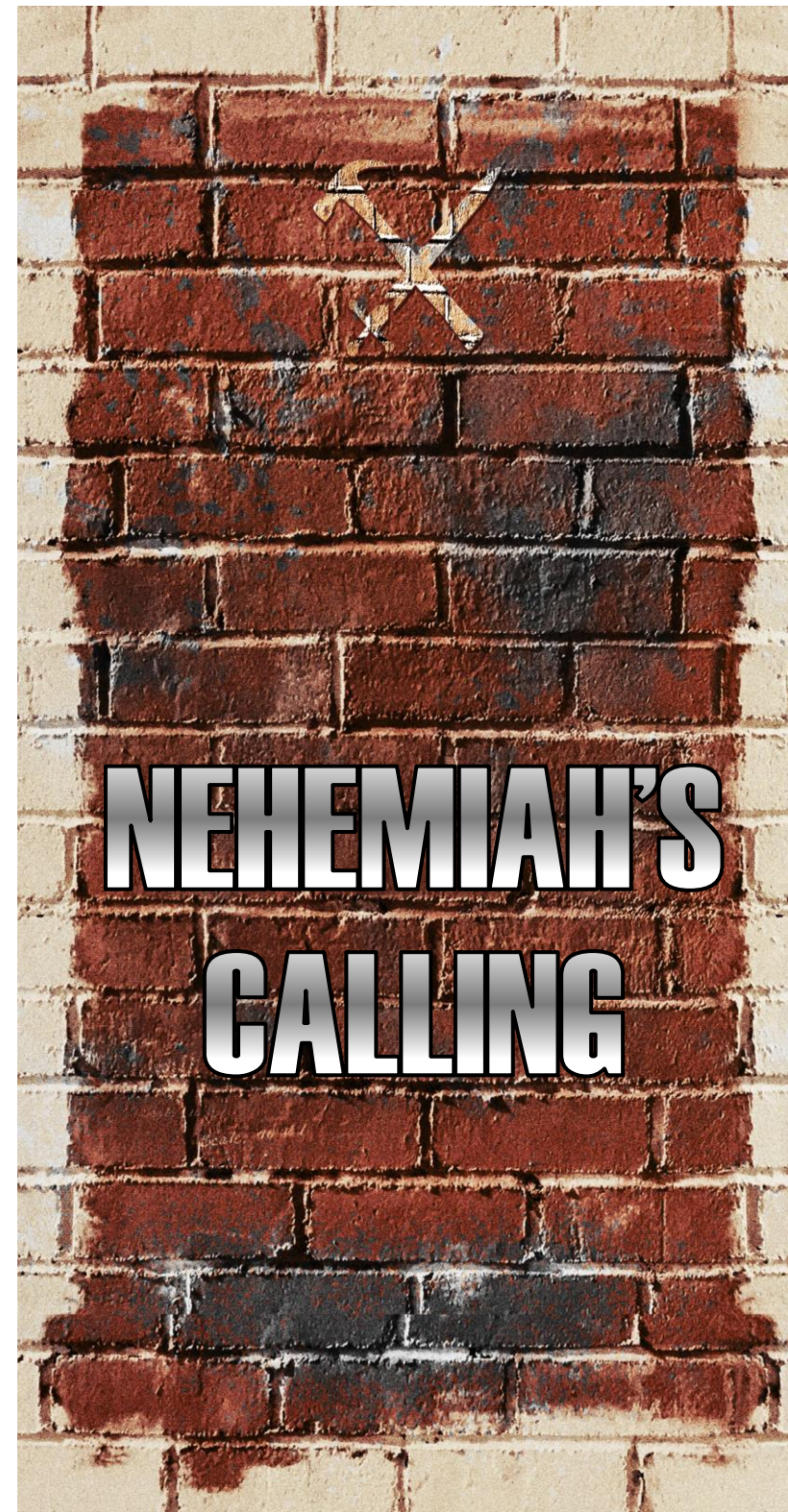
What's Happening @ Westhill During the Renovations Phase 1 (Sanctuary & Foyer)

- ❖ There are two **Sunday morning services** taking place in the FELLOWSHIP ROOM @ 9:30 & 11 AM.
- ❖ **Children's Sunday School classes** for kids 2 years – Grade 5 takes place during the 9:30 AM service.
- ❖ **Youth (Grades 6-12)** will be meeting during the 11 am service.
- ❖ There is **childcare in the nursery** during both services.
- ❖ **The handibus drop-off spot** is beside the Preschool Entrance.
- ❖ **The coffee stations** are located at the South entrance (new) and the kitchen counter (not new!).
- ❖ **Adult COFFEE & LEARN** ("Friend of Sinners") Sunday mornings February 3 - March 3, **during the 11 AM service** in Room 8.
- ❖ There is **NO access to the church through the front doors**.
- ❖ **Where to park** - To make the transition between services as easy as possible we are asking for those **who are mobile and can use the stairs to use the SOUTH parking lot** and for those **who have mobility issues to use the WEST parking lot**.
- ❖ If order to reduce congestion between services, **we ask those attending the 9:30 AM service** not to linger too long after the service.
- ❖ **During the week**, please use the SW/Fellowship Room door.
- ❖ **The Prayer Room** will be in a pastor's office.
- ❖ **All regular mid-week programming** will continue, with possible modifications as to where in the church they take place.
